

HERITAGE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Heritage Advisory Committee is:

1. To assist Council by providing or sourcing background historic information of heritage or potential heritage sites
2. To advise on submissions for heritage assistance grant applications.
3. To provide advice on heritage programming, exhibitions, education and tourism events.
4. To advise on nominations of Heritage Listed items from the Local Environmental Plan (LEP) and to identify items of State significance, which should be included in the NSW heritage Office State Heritage Register or of National Significance.
5. To educate the community on the importance of heritage conservation.
6. To provide advice on the management and balanced treatment of heritage places forming the cultural heritage of the area by identifying places of cultural significance within Penrith Local Government Area and to encourage their ongoing conservation.
7. To work with and liaise with the community in the promotion, education, advocacy, encouragement, understanding and use of the cultural heritage of the city.
8. To be briefed on major development proposals relating to items of heritage significance, with a focus on major developments.
